3. REGISTRATION

Licenses: Only competitors and team officials with a valid IFSC international license are allowed to register for the competition.

Pre-registration: In order to support the efficient organisation of the competitions, it is very important that National Federations register participants to the competitions as early as possible.

Deadline: The deadline for registration is 15 days before the first day of competition (the "Registration Date") on **8 June 2021 at 11:59 PM UTC+0.**

Online Technical Meeting: (as per the Addendum to IFSC Rules)

A representative from each participating Member Federation shall participate to the online Technical meeting lead by the IFSC Technical Delegate.

4. PRE-EVENT REGULATIONS

All participating athletes, officials and organizing staff must submit a negative COVID-19 real-time-PCR test (taken no more than 72 hours prior to the arrival day) to the COVID-19 Delegate, Julia Pinggera at j.pinggera@austriaclimbing.com upon arrival/registration at the event.

All athletes and team officials are recommended to have insurance coverage, covering hospitalization and all other medical coverage if required due to COVID-19 and possible repatriation back to their home country. The IFSC will not be responsible for any of these costs.

5. CONFIRMATION OF ATTENDANCE (as per the Addendum to IFSC Rules)

Participation of all Team Members shall be confirmed upon arrival to location to the IFSC Technical Delegate by phone or via email in the 24 hours period between **20 June at 11:59 PM (UTC +2) and 21 June at 11:59 PM (UTC+2).**

Confirmation of attendance and COVID-rapid-antigen-testing on site

Due to the currently changing legal situation with regards to sporting events in Austria, the testing-procedure is still being updated. All athletes, coaches and other people taking part in the competition will need to be tested regularly. When and where the tests are done will be communicated as soon as possible.

The event will be held under exclusion of the public – No spectators will be allowed.

Athletes will be allowed to watch the competition or at least some parts of the competition. A detailed information on the Athletes Zone will be given shortly before the event.

Covid-19 Regulations at the Kletterzentrum Innsbruck

Due to the legally restricted number of visitors at the Kletterzentrum Innsbruck (Climbing Gym Innsbruck), external team training and group events are, unfortunately, not possible at the moment. The competition areas (lead, boulder, speed) indoor and outdoor are mainly reserved for the national climbing team and the regional climbing team.

The following regulations apply to all visitors to the facility:

- Covid-19 Test for access
- FFP2 mask,
- 2 meter distance at any time,
- the ticket for climbing is valid for a maximum of 3 hours

We would also like to point out that in the outdoor area, preparations for the World Cup will begin on June 6th and all outdoor competition areas will be closed until the end of June.

11. RESPONSE PROTOCOL IN CASE OF POSITIVE RAPID TEST OR SUSPECTED

CASE OF COVID-19

(Procedure as per April 2021)

The person suspected of being infected or having a positive Sars-Cov-2-Test result must be immediately placed in a separate room and kept away from the event. Also the direct contact persons of him/her need to be reported to the Health Department and, in case the local Health-Offices order it, kept away from the competition. To minimize risk, no one is to leave the competition area until health personnel arrive.

1. The contact details are to be kept ready
2. The organizer as well as the Covid19 Delegate and the COVID-19 Response Doctor (Dr. Johanna Rettenbacher) have to be informed immediately.
3. The responsible persons are obliged to contact the health advice immediately:

- c. Written notification of the suspected person incl. contact persons to:
corona-gesundheitsamt@innsbruck.gv.at
4. The contact persons (e.g. all members of the national team who have traveled together) are to be kept away from the event, if the health authorities order to do so. Direct contact persons need to be listed on the Covid-19 Health Check Form provided by the organizer.
5. The responsible persons immediately have to inform the parents/legal guardians or the coach on site of the affected person(s) in case of minors.
6. Further steps will be ordered by the locally responsible health authorities. Testing and similar measures are also carried out on the instructions of the health authorities. They also decide which persons must remain at the competition site for further clarification. As a rule, the person in question will be instructed to come to the Covid test lane (in a private car) where the smear test will be performed.
7. Documentation of which persons have or had contact with the affected person as well as the type of contact (e.g. with the help of participant lists and health check forms).
8. If a case of confirmed illness, further measures are taken in accordance with the instructions of the local health authority.

In order to be able to proceed in an appropriately ordered manner in the event of an incident, a room that is less frequented and can be well ventilated and disinfected will be selected in advance. Furthermore, the contact details of all participants or their legal guardians must be available and participation in competition rounds must be documented (e.g. through participant lists, registration).

To make a safe and fast continuation of the event possible and in accordance with the current Addendum to IFSC Rules, the COVID-19 Response Doctor and the TD will be in contact about the (suspected) case and the further procedure.

APPENDIX I: TRAVEL INFORMATION (Updated on 4 June 2021)

The following information was written on May 31st, according to the Covid-19 restrictions valid at this time. If the travel restrictions change, the information will be updated as soon as possible. The following information is provided without guarantee of legal accuracy. We kindly ask you to check all travel restriction specifically from your country by yourself. These links will help you:

NOTE: Until the 10th of June it is still necessary to log your entry to Austria electronically. Please, fill out the [Pre-Travel-Clearance](https://entry.ptc.gv.at/en) (<https://entry.ptc.gv.at/en>) as a minimum requirement to enter Austria from all countries! For entry after the 10th of June this is only necessary coming from a high-risk country.

A) Entering Austria from low-risk countries:

Low risk countries are the countries on [this](#) list:

You need to be tested, vaccinated or recovered from Covid-19 and can enter without quarantine.

- Vaccinated means: You are fully vaccinated, or your first vaccination dose happened at least 22 days before traveling but no longer than three months ago. The vaccines that are accepted in Austria are: BioNtech/Pfizer, AstraZeneca, Janssen, Moderna, Sinopharm.
- Tested: Antigen Test negative certificate 48 hours / PCR Test negative certificate 72 hours (English or German certificate)
- Recovered: German or English certificate of antibodies not older than 3 months.

B) Entering Austria from high-risk countries or any other countries not on the lists from point A) or point C):

- If you are vaccinated or recovered you will not need to quarantine.
- If you enter with a Covid-Test only you usually have to go to quarantine for at least 5 days
- The exception for business travelers is still in place. All athletes and coaches traveling to this event count as business travelers. You need to follow all of the steps below to be able to enter without quarantine:
 - Show a certificate of a negative Covid test (English or German, printed or digital).
 - Bring a confirmation from your National Federation stating that you travel for business (including the name of the event you go to, the names + ID number of all Team Members)
 - Fill out Pre-Travel-Clearance (<https://entry.ptc.gv.at/en>)

C) Entering Austria from virus-mutation countries:

Regulations for: *Brazil, South Africa, UK, India (as of June 1st)*

Flight bans as well as travel restrictions are in place for these countries at least until June 20th.

The exception for business travelers does not apply to people entering Austria from these countries.

If you still want to enter Austria from one of these countries the following measures apply:

- Fill out the [Pre-Travel-Clearance](https://entry.ptc.gv.at/en) Form (<https://entry.ptc.gv.at/en>) shortly before your departure. You can find all necessary information while filling out the form.
- You need to have a certificate of a valid, negative PCR-Test not older than 72 hours when entering the country also if you are already recovered or vaccinated. (English or German certificate)
- Get into quarantine for 10-days following your entry. The quarantine can be ended with a negative PCR test on the 5th day after arrival.

Please keep in mind that the lists of countries are constantly updated, so please check the list before traveling. The information on the Info Sheet will also be updated in case any links or the regulations change.

Please inform yourself as much as possible about the travel restrictions specifically for your country. You can also contact Julia Pinggera (j.pinggera@austriaclimbing.com) if you have any further question. Please keep in mind that we can also only inform ourselves online and with the help of the Ministries – In order to conserve our resources, we ask you to research as much as possible on your own!
