ENTRY VISA APPLICATION PROCESS UPDATE

WHO HAS TO APPLY FOR AN ENTRY VISA?

Get general information on visa requirements of your individual country.

WHICH VISA SHOULD YOU APPLY FOR?

For short stays up to 90 days you will need to apply for a Schengen Visa. If your entry country to Europe is not Austria, you will need to check country specific regulations.

WHEN TO APPLY FOR A SCHENGEN VISA?

Visa application and processing times vary from country to country. Please check with the <u>Austrian Embassy</u> in your country if you have to make an appointment and by when to need to submit your application to get the visa in time for travelling.

HOW TO APPLY FOR A SCHENGEN VISA?

You can download your visa application form.

Before starting to fill in the form, please have your valid identify card or passport as well as travel documents to hand.

REQUIREMENTS FOR THE ISSUE OF SHORT STAY (SCHENGEN) VISAS

There is no automatic entitlement to a Schengen Visa. The Austrian Embassy in your country must ensure that the following requirements have been met in each individual case:

- 1. An eligible passport valid for at least 3 months after the trip
- 2. Two recent photographs, passport-sized
- 3. Proof of sufficient funds to cover the stay in Austria
- 4. Travel Insurance with minimum €30,000 coverage
- 5. A letter explaining the purpose of the trip to Austria
- 6. Proof of accommodation, such as hotel reservations
- 7. A travel itinerary for Austria, including entry and exit dates and flight numbers

ARRIVAL

Transport for all accredited participants will be arranged from Innsbruck airport and Innsbruck main train station only.



By Plane

Innsbruck Airport is a small, regional airport, located on the western edge of the city with direct flights to international destinations such as Vienna, Frankfurt or London. Munich airport (Germany) with good train connections to Innsbruck can be a convenient way of travelling to Innsbruck.

By Car

Innsbruck / Stubai is located on major traffic routes with well-developed road networks, which makes the region easily accessible by car.

From Italy: A22/A13 (Brenner motorway); tolls apply from the exit Innsbruck-Süd.

Now you can register as a new customer with an e-mail address and book your journey to the event in a relaxed manner.

It should be noted that each person must create a new ÖBB account specifically for this event. An existing ÖBB account cannot be used because each e-mail address can only be used once in the ÖBB booking system.

By registering, you will receive a 22% championship discount on the ÖBB standard price, 10% on the international standard price and a special price for the ÖBB Nightjet during the time period of of 22nd of May till 13th of June 2023. Your customer account for the congress will be automatically deleted after the end of the event and thus after your return journey.

Please note that the respective ÖBB cancellation conditions of the selected fare also apply if the event is cancelled.

SHUTTLE SYSTEM

The sophisticated transportation concept includes a permanent transport service between the two venues Neustift and Innsbruck. At expected peak times (e.g., before the competitions), separate shuttles for Athletes will be set up to guarantee an uncomplicated and easy arrival to the races. We kindly ask all teams to make use of our transport concept not only for ecological reasons but to avoid congestions, too. Both Venues offer several facilities (showers, dedicated rest areas, team catering, etc.) to reduce the usage of permanent shuttles to the needs of the Athletes only.

ACCOMMODATION UPDATE

The World Mountain and Trail Running Championships 2023 are hosted in Innsbruck and Stubai. Allocation will be done by the LOC equally between the two regions based on the accommodation requirements indicated in the Final Entries.

Accommodation Costs

The LOC is covering the costs for 4 nights for participating quota Athletes and team officials during the event. For all quota Athletes running two races, a 5th night is covered by the LOC. Regarding all non-quota Athletes, additional officials and additional nights, the federation will be charged 100€ per person per night for accommodation and the full board.

Please note that participation at WMTRC23 can only be granted if invoicing amounts are fully paid!

Cancellation policy: Please note that any cancellation/no-show in accommodation after 30 days before arrival will be fully (100%) charged to the Federation.

Extra Charges

Extras (e.g. laundry, parking, mini bar) have to be paid in cash or credit card directly at the hotel by the Federation.

The respective team leader will be required to deposit a credit card as guarantee for the teams extra charges. Any not settled extras (e.g. phone bills or other extra services at the hotel) have to be covered by the team leader at check-out.

Extra Services

Meeting Rooms

If there is a need for a meeting room please inform us in due time, since they need to be booked in advance. However, please note that not all of the hotels are equipped with meeting rooms, nevertheless the LOC is going to help with any meeting room requests and arrangements can be made.

Internet Access

Free internet access will be provided at each hotel.

Check-in / check-out

Check-in and Check-out times differ depending on the allocated hotel Please note that early check-in depends on availability. In general, it is necessary that the team leader provides a credit card as a guarantee for any extra expenses to the hotel during check-in. Furthermore, the teams are encouraged to arrive as a group, since the team leader has to do a group check-in where they will be provided with all the room keys and it is their responsibility to distribute them within the team. Same procedure during the check-out, the team leader has to collectively hand in the keys during check-out and needs to pay any additional service the team might have consumed.



CATERING UPDATE

Meals

The accommodation booking comes with a full board service on competition days. For lunch and dinner one beverage will be available free of charge. Additional drinks must be paid for.

Breakfast

For every night booked in one of our official hotels breakfast will be served at each hotel in continental buffet style at their respective catering areas.

Lunch

On competition days (from 7^{th} to 10^{th} of June 2023) lunch will be served to all accredited team members (Athletes and officials) at the respective catering area in both venues. There will be vegetarian and vegan options every day.

On days outside the official competition days, the participating Member Federations remain in charge of arranging lunch for their team members in line with their preferences.

Dinner

During the official event period (from 6^{th} to 10^{th} of June 2023) dinner will be served to all accredited team members at the respective catering area in both venues. There will be vegetarian and vegan options every day.

On days outside of the official event period, the participating Member Federations remain in charge of arranging lunch and dinner for their team members in line with their preferences.







Overall Federation Team Award

In addition to the individual team championships for mountain and trail, the World MTR Championships Partners want to recognise Federations who are successful across the range of events by introducing an overall senior team trophy.

There will be a trophy for the Federation that scores highest from a number of the senior races both mountain and trail. There are 8 senior events: $2 \times 2 \times 10^{-5}$ x mountain races (uphill/vertical uphill and classic) and 2×10^{-5} trail races (short and long), male and female races.

The team trophy will be calculated on up to each Federation's 6 best event scores; with each event score being based on up to the Federation's top 3 runners in that event. All teams will be ranked and Team Trophies will be awarded to the top three Federations!

All media facilities will be accessible for media representatives of the international and national Federations. If you want to accredit your own media people (e.g., communications manager, photographer, social media manager), please note that a person can hold only one accreditation card. Staff from your delegation should be accredited as team members and can, in case of necessity and eligibility, receive a Supplementary Access Control Devices (SACD), if requested beforehand.

LIVE EVENT PRODUCTION UPDATE

In order to offer the best experience for spectators on-air and on-site, live event production plays an central role in our planning. As a result of continuous and detailed planning we'll provide high quality live streams of every competition (that you will hopefully share via your channels). The distribution concept foresees a 360° approach for all platforms- tv, online, social media and radio. A key partnership has been established with Austria's public broadcaster, ORF, who recently committed to an extensive coverage on their own platforms, including additional features from the competition and integration into their other formats and shows.

The coverage of the races follows a simple concept: explain the sport for a broad audience and show the excitement of the races in the picturesque scenery of the Austrian landscape in order to promote and celebrate the sport and their Athletes across the globe.
