TRAVEL DETAILS

by plane: Fly to Innsbruck - there are direct flights from Paris, London, Frankfurt, Vienna

and Zürich. From the airport take a bus to the railway station and from there go

by train to Imst. From the station take a bus or taxi.

by train: Most of the international trains stop in Imst.

by car: Coming from Munich or Italy take the highway to Innsbruck, proceed on the

highway in direction "Arlberg-Bregenz", after 60 km leave at the first exit

"Imst".

Coming from Switzerland take the highway in direction to Innsbruck, drive over the Arlberg-Passes (the tunnel is locked) and leave at the second exit "Imst".
